Victoria Police Legacy was founded in 1980. Its purpose is to provide on-going support for the families of deceased police members.

Today with an expanded charter, that tradition continues.

Our Role

Victoria Police Legacy is a charitable organisation that provides a range of services to police families who have suffered the loss of a loved one.

Should a police officer either serving or retired, or their spouse/partner die, Victoria Police Legacy is there to help the spouse/partner and children who are left behind. We provide ongoing support to Police Family members across the state.

Funding is provided mainly through fortnightly tax deductible payroll contributions from serving police members. Your small regular contribution will be assisting the families of those who have served.

Other funding comes from bequests and tax free donations, often from retired police members or members of the public expressing appreciation for work done by police in the community.

At Victoria Police Legacy we are committed to meeting the needs of those for whom we care.

What will Police Legacy do if you or your spouse/partner dies?

Once we have been notified Victoria Police Legacy will contact the surviving spouse/partner. Shortly afterwards they will be contacted by our Field Officer who will arrange a personal visit and explain the support and services we offer and answer any questions.
